The Northern European Cup releases the official calendar for 2010!

NEC is getting ready for the fifth edition of the international single seater series in Northern Europe! By extending the calendar to 20 races in 8 weekends, young driver talent from across Europe gets the chance to race their 2009 and 2010 editions of the Formula Renault 2.0 on the best tracks of the Northern European Region.

Next to the continued weekends, like the Racing Festival on world famous Spa Francorchamps, new events have been taken into to calendar this year. NEC participates in A-list events such as the the Czech Championship at Brno in April and the Masters of Formula 3 at Circuit Park Zandvoort in June.

With an increased number of races, in an equal number of events, NEC hits two targets at once. One the one side, young drivers get the chance to race more than in any other Formula Renault 2.0 championship in Europe, giving them more opportunity to gain experience and develop their skills in formula racing. On the other hand, the running costs of the teams will not increase because the races are spread over the same number of weekends, ensuring that the relatively low budget of the series remains.

The two-litre single-seaters kick off with four official test days before starting its international racing calendar. The organization has arranged two days of testing on the 29th and 30th of March on the EUROcup track Hockenheim and continues to Oschersleben right after. The 31st of March and the 1st of April can be used by any 2009 or 2010 Formula Renault, or other single-seater driver to explore the car and track near the city of Magdeburg in the east of Germany.
